- Banks ran out of money

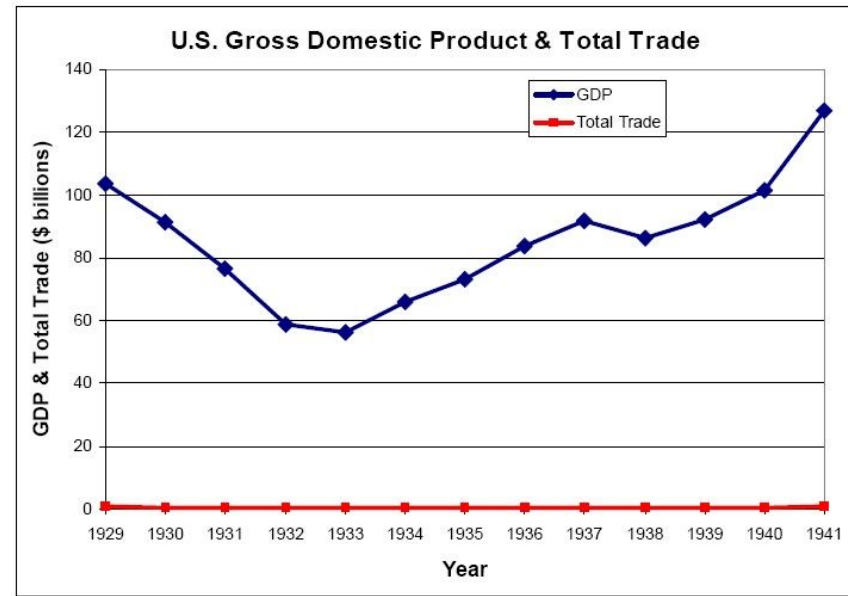


High Tariffs
