- Soviets cut off access to West Berlin
- Response Airlift supplies
- Soviets open access after 11 months






Arms Race

- Recruited German Scientists to develop weapons
- Defense Money Spent on development
 - Hydrogen Bomb
- Development was matched by Soviets



- •NATO North Atlantic Treaty Organization
 - Alliance of Non Communist nations
- Response Warsaw Pact
 - alliance of communist nations




Communism Grows in Asia

- China goes Communist in 1949
- Korea divided along 38th parallel
 - North Korea Communist
 - South Korea Democracy
- June 25, 1950 North invaded South



Response to Attack

- United Nations opposed
- Called a "Police Action"
- 16 UN nations supported the effort.



United Nations Police Action

- Mission: Remove Communists from South Korea
- China entered war November 1950
- Summer 1951 China agreed to Peace Talks
- Armistice 1953 Boundary 38th Parallel



Eisenhower Response to Communism

- Eisenhower Doctrine Aid given to Middle East
- Kitchen Debates Merits of Communism vs. Capitalism
 - Khrushchev vs. Nixon



"Mass Retaliation" and Brinkmanship

- Soviet and Chinese aggression would be countered with the threat of nuclear weapons
- Never back down from a crisis, even if it meant pushing the nation to the "brink of war"

• If one nation falls to communism other nearby nations will fall as well




