
# END OF WORLD WAR II

- Berlin divided as well








#### UNITED NATIONS

  - Votes to participate in military action






#### **COLD WAR BEGINS**

#### U.S. PERSPECTIVE


- •International peace and prosperity

- Use the United Nations to solve problems




- Spread of Communism vs. Spread of Democracy
