

Religious Right




- Conservative, evangelical Christians

- Increased productivity leads to an increase in the supply of goods which causes prices to drop








WHERE MONEY WAS SPENT

- Economic Goal: Reduce the federal budget by
 \$35 billion while increasing defense spending
 - Largest military build up during peacetime
- Peace through Strength to discourage other countries from engaging the US military



REAGANOMICS

- Reduce government power by deregulation
- Cutting back on the federal control of industry/economy
 - Airline industry
 - Savings and loans
 - Removed price controls on oil

Economic Legacy

- Reduced taxes and increased military spending → huge deficit
- Huge deficit curbed future welfare state
- Growing income gap
- Deregulation of economy



Lebanon Violence

- U.S. forces sent to Beirut as part of an international peacekeeping force
- Suicide bomber crashed into barracks and killed 241 Marines
- Reagan withdrew troops

- Two other court appointments cause a shift in the court to more conservative policies




ELECTION OF 1984

 - VP Candidate Geraldine Ferraro first woman on major party ticket








IRAN CONTRA AFFAIR

- Two Problems:
 - Americans taken hostage in Lebanon by terrorists
 - Congress refused to appropriate funds to help contra rebels in Nicaragua
- Solution: Officials secretly sold arms to Iranians
 - Money from sales sent to contra rebels
 - Iranians help in negotiations to release hostages
- Reaction from public: Actions of executive branch were unconstitutional
 - Money sent to other countries by the US is congress' choice

Iran-Contra Affair

Public uproar:

- "Teflon" Reagan: maintained his innocence
- Oliver North and John Poindexterguilty of criminal behavior (convictions reversed on appeal)
- Sec. of Defense Caspar Weinberger-pardoned before put on trial
