- Criticism: propagandistic and anti-militaristic.
- Made only a dozen years after the Great War

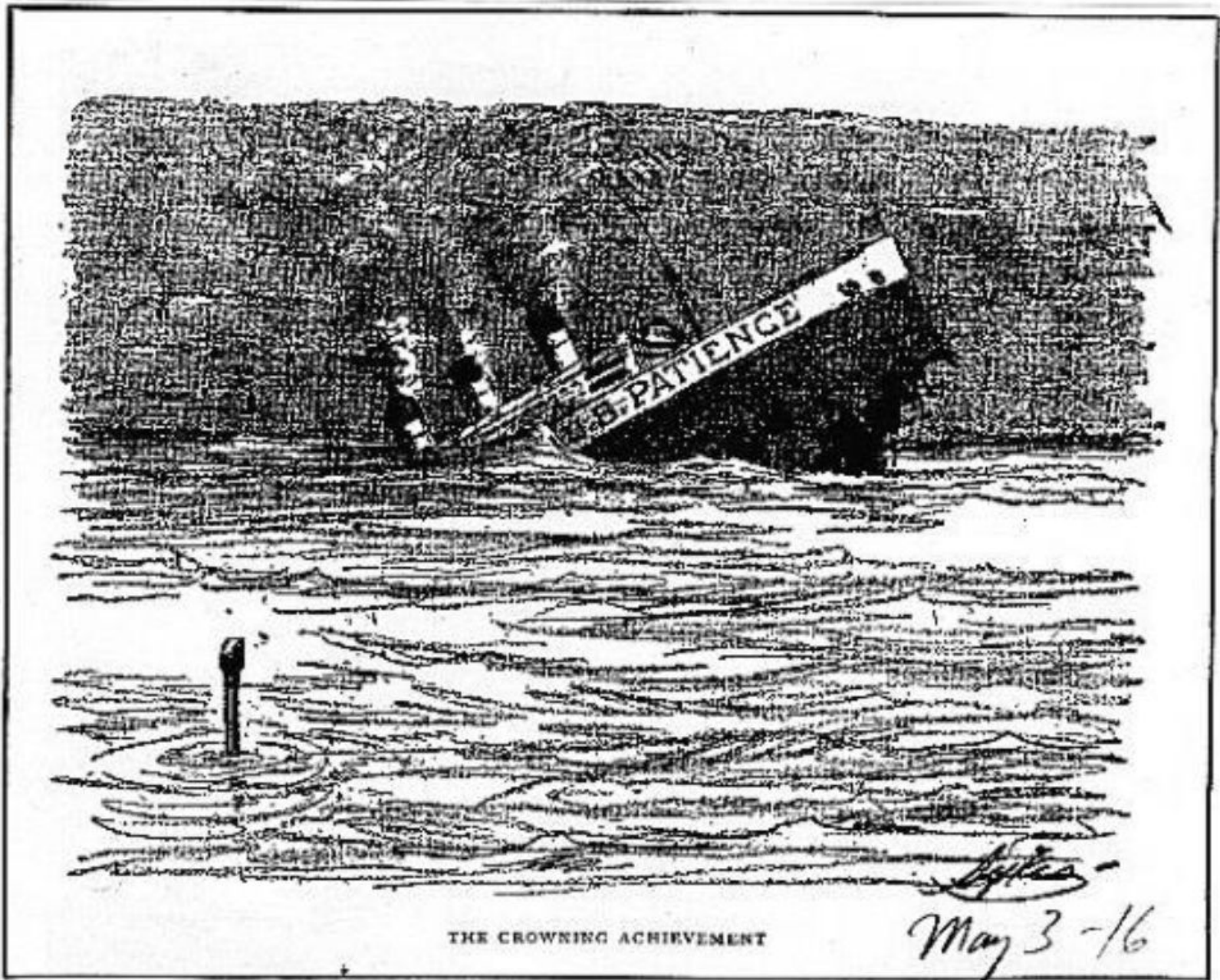
- True story of a hillbilly sharpshooter drafted in WW1 despite his claim to be a pacifist, who ends up becoming a war hero.
